Entered service Jan 1, 1941, assigned to Co E 57th Quartermaster in Livingstone, LA, with rank of sergeant.

Served in New Guinea from November 14, 1942. Left Yokohama November, 1945 to return home through Seattle, WA.

He was a staff sergeant at 337th Ordnance Depot %San Francisco.

Contracted malaria in the Philippines. His twin brother Roy not in service because he was married with children.

Ray married Arlene Waters Gunnlaugsson, daughter of Mrs Berndt Gunnlaugsson and Ray Clyde Anderson on August 16, 1947. The dance was held at Tom Nelson's. They had three children.

Worked with his father on the freighters. His father was called 'Curly Chris'. Ray and Roy ran freight between the Island and Green Bay. They also had a farm next to Martin Anderson's.

He joined the Island America Legion Post 402 in 1945.
