According to Jessie Miner, Burbage was an old man who lived at Harrison's Point on Washington Island during the 1850's and 60's. He had been an English drummer boy at the battle of Waterloo. No other reference to him is known. Harrison Point is now called Indian Point. Ray Ransom bought the land from Mad Swenson who had bought the property from Burbage. (Also spelled Berbage.)
