Entered the Army January 15, 1943 at Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He sailed from San Francisco on October 7, 1943 on *the Sea Pike* to Brisbane, Australia, landing October 27, 1943. He returned to the States from Okinawa (December 18, 1945) landing in California on January 5, 1946. He was discharged at Camp McCoy, Wisconsin on January 15, 1946 with the rank of storekeeper 2c.

He served - in the 49th Ordnance MM Company AGF January 22 to May 7, 1943, in the 539th Ordnance HM Company AGF from May 7, 1943 to September 27, 1943, and the 617th Ordnance CO Ammunition Co from February 2, 1944 to January 15, 1946. His camps and stations were Camp Hood, Detroit Tank Engine School Camp Stan, California.

His action included New Guinea, the Leyte Gulf, and Naha, Okinawa. The battles were in New Guinea, the Phillipines, and Okinawa as a member of the 617th Ordnance.

His medals include the Bronze Star, Good Conduct, Asia Pacific Theater Service, and Philippine Liberation.

Married Amelia Ruel in October 1953, the daughter of Lester and Ann. Had a son Arnold Leroy Jr. who was born October 9, 1954 and who comes to the Island occasionally
