His parents were Charles (Charlie) Hagen and Thora Hansen.

He joined the US Army Air Force on January 30, 1943, and won his pilot's wings and commission on March 12, 1944, and arrived in Italy in September. He was a member of a heavy bombardment group which flew more than 200 combat missions against strategic enemy targets in Nazi occupied Europe. For its outstanding performances in the Mediterranean Theatre of Operations it was cited twice by the War Department.

He received the Air Medal while serving as pilot of a B-24 Liberator at 15th Air AAF base in Italy. It was given for "meritorious achievement in aerial flight while participation in sustainer operational activities against the enemy."
