He was in the Army in 1950 in 213 AFA Bn 9 Co.

Richard drowned on July 10, 1955, while lifting perch nets off Mt. Misery. His body was found at noon on July 12 by the Coast Guard. Lloyd Young also drowned, but Richard's brother Thomas was able to swim to shore. Richard left behind his wife and two young daughters.

Parents were Ben Johnson and Annabel Jacobsen. He owned the grocery store which is now Fiddler's Green.
