“George Larson fished on Rock Island from 1867 to 1874. He came from Racine, Wisconsin, served in a Wisconsin regiment and claimed to be one of the youngest soldiers in the service, being hardly fifteen years old at the time of enlistment. He went from Rock Island to Poverty Island Lighthouse in 1874, where he staid (sic) over eight years, going to Bailey’s Harbor Lighthouse in the fall of 1882.” *Rock Island*
