He was chaplain of the American Legion Post 402 in 1939-40.

Married Margaret Nugent (5/11/1881-12/26/1970) on June 19, 1899. Their children were Vernon, James, Vera (Mrs. Arthur Young)

Son was Ernest Royal Lockhart.

He was buried from the Bethel Church with military honors. His pall bearers were Roland Koyen, Ray Krause, William Jacobsen, Ralph Jacobsen, Gordon Jepson, and Mack Magnusson.
