Organizations: 15th Air Force, 99th Bombardment Group 1944-5/1945 at Ft. Foggia, Italy. He was turret ball gunner on B-17s.

Camps: Jackson, TN; San Antonio, TX; Scott Field, IL; Lowry Field, Denver; Kingman Air Base AZ; Lincoln, NE; Kasmery, England; Island of Capri.

Battles: Rome, Arno Camp, Northern Italy, Southern France, Eastern Germany, Austria, Western Germany, and Berlin Campaign as member of 15th Air Force.

He was engaged at Berlin, Vienna, Regensburg-Salzburg, Brod, Yugoslavia, Mossmerbaum, Bleckhommer, Vdume.

Left port of Boston 7/17,1944, arriving Iceland, then to Belfast, Ireland, and camped at New Bedford, England. Sailed from Italy on *SS Mt. Vernon*, 5/15/1945, arriving NY 5/29/1945 as a member of 15th Air Force.

Medals include Air Medal with three oak leaf clusters, three Presidential citations, European Theater with eight battle stars, Good Conduct.

Lived in Sturgeon Bay after service, built storage units. His brothers were Maynard and Peter. (JG)

His parents were Frank Oleson and Mary Alice Knudsen.

He married Bette Fischer 7/6/1944.

Later married Arline Stephenson 12/17/1947, who was born 4/23/1927.
